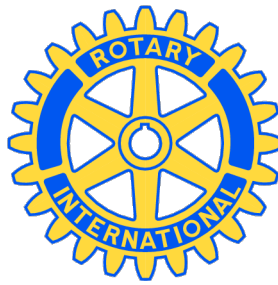

Rotary Club of Bar Harbor (Mount Desert Island) Maine Club Golden Apple Award – Criteria

DESCRIPTION: An award, including a \$1,000 honorarium, given annually to the MDI educator (we use this word broadly and the nominee could include a teacher, guidance counselor, or any school staff member – if they teach students, they are eligible) who best exemplifies the decision criteria below.

PROCEDURE: The recipient will be selected from among recommendations submitted by community members, teachers, students, and school staff. Recommendations will be made on an application form developed by the MDI Rotary club and submitted to the Club Administration Committee for review and recommendation of the top three candidates to the board of directors. The award will be made in June.

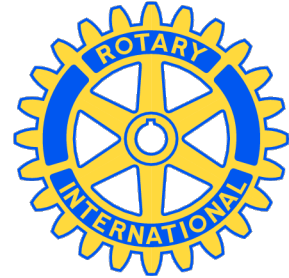
CRITERIA: The successful candidate:

1. Is recommended as an outstanding educator
2. Is not a previous recipient of the Rotary Golden Apple Award
3. Reflects the principles of Rotary, including:
 - a. Holds to high ethical standards
 - b. Considers his/her occupation an opportunity to serve
 - c. Is faithful to the ethical codes of the educating profession and the laws of the country
 - d. Does all in his/her power to dignify the educating profession and to promote the highest ethical standards of the educating profession
 - e. Is fair to administrators, associates, students, the public, and all those with whom he/she has a professional relationship
 - f. Recognizes the honor and respect due to all occupations, which are useful to society
 - g. Offers his/her vocational talents to provide opportunities for young people to work for the needs of others and to improve the quality of life in the community
 - h. Adheres to honesty in all representations to the public about the educating profession.
4. Inspires his/her students to learn, through creativity, and effectiveness in the classroom.
5. Educates in such a way that results in his/her students' motivation to learn
6. Aspires to go on with his/her education, learning how to be a better educator
7. Regularly contributes to the life of the school in which he/she educates
8. Will participate in a public recognition ceremony at which this award will be made

 - d. provides opportunities for students that improve the overall quality of life in the community, and
4. inspires and motivates students to learn through creativity and effectiveness.
