Applicant Must:

Be a Class of 2023 High School graduate, AND:

- Be a resident of Sheboygan County or be a member of the current graduating class of a high school located in Sheboygan County.
- Have a cumulative minimum "B" (3.0) grade point average for all years of high school attendance.
- Demonstrate a capacity for leadership and good character qualities.
- Show active involvement and leadership in community, school, work, and/or church activities.
- Applicant achievements must be representative of those that would be attributed to a "good" and "involved" student.

Note:

- 1. Acceptance of any other scholarship(s) shall not preclude acceptance; however, a candidate's receipt of other significant scholarship funding may be taken into account as a factor in final selection.
- The proceeds of the award shall be used to assist the recipient in meeting tuition, room, board, fees, and other institutional charges associated with advanced education in a full course of study leading to a degree at a college, university, technical/trade school or their equivalent.
- 3. One eight-thousand-dollar (\$8,000) scholarship will be awarded to the finalist. The scholarship will be disbursed (for purposes as described above) for the first two semesters (\$4,000 each semester) of the student's first year of college commencing JULY 1 of the year the scholarship is awarded.
- 4. Applications must be completed on the "Sheboygan Rotary Scholarship Application" fillable PDF form, available on the Sheboygan Rotary Club website: www.sheboyganrotary.com.

- 6. If you are chosen as a finalist an interview will take place on Wednesday, April 12th between 4pm to 6pm at Pine Hills Country Club.
