The Speaker for the Day was Lisa Senac, Executive Director of the Healthy Living and Life Skills, YMCA. Lisa gave a very engaging and sincere talk about the *Fuel Up Livonia* summer lunch program. 30% of school-age children in Livonia qualify for the free and reduced lunch program. This past summer we had 37 volunteers and 158 different children during the 6-week program, averaging 22 per day, rain or shine! A sobering statistic is that 21 million U.S. children receive free lunches at school, but only 2.3 million get it during the summer.


