100 year anniversary – Centenial Anniversay

•1917 First World Rotary Conference: first donation!

RI President Arch Klumph: \$26.50

Great idea but there was no process how to accept the donation nor how to manage it!

•the name TRF was created in 1928

"We should not live for ourselves alone, but for the joy in doing good for others" .. Arch Klumph





•1929 - first project


First significant grant from TRF was \$500 to:

"International Society for Crippled Children"

•1937 - the first ,fundraising' objective

\$ 2m today: \$ 27m






- 1947 PAUL P. HARRIS died
 10\$/100 \$: every Rotarian donated
- A fund was created for 18 scholarships
 Ambassadorial Scholarships
- 1947

was the first TRF program

1948 – 2015: total 41.700 scholarships







- was an idea that each Rotarian would donate something.....eg: \$100 = \$120m
- Each of us in the District donates \$35 from our District membership dues which means circa \$25,000 per year
 depends on the number of Rotarians/members!
- it means that 3 years later the District has circa \$12,000 for District Grants and the same amount accumulates annually for Global Grants

However, if there were no major donors...in USA, Canada, Japan, Taiwan, Australia, UK, Spain, Portugal, Germany and Austria plus each Rotarian then TRF would not have \$120m for projects a programs each year!

In nearly 100 years, TRF has distributed \$3billion on projects

TRF is our Foundation... It belongs to us!.....we support mutual understanding, help the under priveleged and change lives!...

1965/6 new programmes:

GSE: 72,500 participants by 2013

Activity grants & Matching Grants: total 37,500

• 2013-2014: new programmes, new model: has to fit to the 6 Areas of Focus

water/sanitation, peace and conflict resolution, mother and child health, disease prevention, education and literacy, community and economic development

- 2013-2015: total
 - 1.949 Global Grants
 - 977 District Grants





2014-2015: 1,078 GG: distributed \$28.9m

only 9% applications rejected

488 DG: \$25m

• 2015-2016: 345 GG: \$16m

247 DG: \$21m

disease prevention, water, literacy.......... only 6% rejected

BUTTRF is more than grants.....





- Peace Fellowships: each year TRF chooses10 students nominated by clubs to 5 Universities in the world to study conflict resolution...these are our Alumni...
- End Polio Now: in 30 years: \$11billion
 1985: 400,000 in 125 countries.....today 36 v 2!

1988-2018.....183 m children saved!

2013-2018: for every \$ from TRF, Gates Foundation will donate 2\$ to \$35m p.a...in 2 years TRF has given already \$35m and Gates 70m.......





We are 'that close'

to eradicating Polio
