Flexible Attendance Policy

At EPNR, we value flexibility and recognize that life can get busy. While Rotary International encourages 50% attendance, our club believes that fellowship is more important than strict rules. Attend as often as you can. The more you engage, the more rewarding your experience will be and the more you'll get from your membership.

Financial Commitment

Here is a breakdown of the membership costs:

- **Quarterly Dues:** \$80 includes contributions to Rotary International (\$25), District 5950 (\$30), and our club (\$25)
- **Meal Costs:** \$162 per quarter covers nine meals (currently \$18 each) for our regular Thursday meetings
- **Total Quarterly Cost:** \$242, Annual Cost: \$968

As a **welcoming gift** to new members, you'll pay **only quarterly dues** your first six months.
