The Application Process:

New members must be proposed by current members of the club.

Expectations of Members:

- 1. Active participation on at least one of our many committees. This is a great way to get to know other members and strengthen our connection to one another.
- 2. Support the activities of the club whenever possible with both time and treasure.
- 3. Upon acceptance, new members are issued a red name badge and enrolled in our NEOS Club. This helps new members develop an understanding of what is unique about Rotary and Rotarians. Once certain requirements are met related to service and participation, NEOS members are inducted to permanent membership at a "Change of Badge" ceremony and given a blue badge.

Members' Financial Obligations:

- 1. Admission Fee (one-time payable with application-waived if former Rotarian): \$250.00
- 2. Annual Dues (due each June for the period Jul 1-Jun 30): Currently \$460 (subject to change each May 1; dues are pro-rated at time of application for months remaining until Jun 30). Monthly payments can be arranged.
- 3. Members pay for their lunch at our weekly meetings. Pricing published in our Newsletter.
- 4. Although not required, we provide many opportunities for you to make suggested contributions to our local Lincoln Rotary Club 14 Foundation, and The Rotary (International) Foundation, to support our charitable causes.
