## Instructions for submitting Student Names for Honor Roll:

We kindly request the submission of your selected students' names at your earliest convenience, with a deadline no later than January 31, 2024. The Rotary Club of Omaha places a strong emphasis on accurate name spelling and greatly appreciates your cooperation in this regard.

To submit student names, please complete the electronic form available here.

By April 6, 2024, we will deliver a packet to your school, containing individual letters for each honored student. We kindly request that you either hand-deliver these letters to the students or send them directly to their parents/guardians. Rotary will no longer send printed letters directly to parents. To facilitate this process, please ensure that you provide email addresses in the nomination forms as we will also send out an email with the relevant information.

Now is a good time to assess your Rotary Honor Roll plaque. If it is full and you require a supplemental one, please contact us at honorroll@omaharotary.org.

The 2024 Honor Roll event will take place in person on April 30, 2024, Tuesday, from 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM at the CHI Health Center.

As a reminder, Rotary Honor Roll recipients should be selected at a 1-to-20 ratio of the entire 8th-grade class. For schools with 20 to 40 enrolled 8th graders, two students may be chosen. Schools with fewer than 20 enrolled 8th graders may select only one student. Please refrain from submitting more names than allotted to maintain fairness in our selection process.

The selection of Rotary Honor Roll recipients should not be influenced by a "popularity" contest. Recipients should embody the following four categories:

- Leadership Demonstrates the ability to collaborate effectively, values others' opinions, and exhibits honesty, dependability, and reliability.
- Character Exhibits kindness, courtesy, responsibility, and respect for others and the environment.
- Scholarship Displays a genuine interest in learning, takes ownership of academic performance, and respects teachers and the learning environment.
- Presence Behaves appropriately, demonstrates self-respect and respect for others in attire, speech, and actions, and presents a positive self-image.
