## Checking in with...Local Grants Committee

The Local Grants Committee and the Board of Directors have adopted changes to the local grant funding process. There has been a new Grant Application Form created and Local Grant Application Guidelines published. The application form and the guidelines are available on our website at [www.edinarotary.org](http://www.edinarotary.org). They can be found in the lower left corner in an area designated "Download."

The Guidelines provide:

The Local Grants Committee may favor grant requests that:	The Local Grants Committee may not favor grants for:
Provide for sustainable projects – projects that are tangible and self-perpetuating	Individual persons
Will be used, primarily, within Edina and its surrounding communities	Religious organizations for purely religious purposes
Create partnerships with other organizations and clubs	Major capital fund drives or endowment funds (or portions thereof)
Increase Rotarians' participation in projects	Organizations primarily engaged in lobbying or political activity
Provide benefits to many (versus a few)	Basic or applied research
Can be leveraged over time	Travel and transportation support
Has club member sponsorship	General operating budget support
	Supplementing or paying for salaries
	Special events, one-time events, tickets, benefits
	Benefits to our club or its members
	Consumable items

The grant application process has changed as well. Rather than awarding grants throughout the year, there is a grant application deadline of Dec. 31. Generally, grants will be awarded in January and February of each year. (However, the committee reserves the right to deviate from these guidelines and award grants at other times if a need arises.)

If you know of possible applicants please advise them of the deadline, the guidelines and the application form.

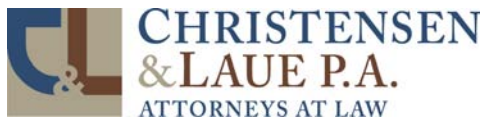
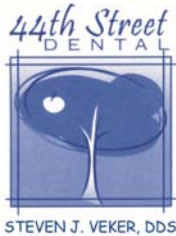

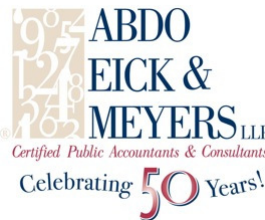
