City of Edina/Edina Police Department Blood Drive set for Monday, Dec. 9

What? City of Edina/Edina Police Department Blood Drive When? Monday, Dec. 9, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Where? Edina City Hall in the Council Chambers

The City of Edina is sponsoring a blood drive with nonprofit partner Memorial Blood Centers. All who live or work in Edina are encouraged to donate blood that day at Edina City Hall, 4801 W. 50th St. Donors must be at least 17 years old or 16 with a signed parental consent form, weigh at least 110 pounds, free of antibiotics for at least 24 hours unless taken daily for a skin condition, and symptom-free for at least three days following a cold or flu.

This summer, the Edina Police Department took first place in the Battle of the Badges blood drive competition for the second consecutive year. Sgt. Kevin Rofidal, who helped to organize the event, said the City is hoping for another great turnout from the community and a goal of 53 units of blood at the December event.


Blood donation is easy and typically takes less than an hour! And located at Edina City Hall, it couldn't be more convenient. Rotarians are encouraged to sign up today!

Rotary Youth Exchange


Rotary Youth Exchange student Asher Knudson is enjoying his time in Norway! Asher recently sent photos from some of his adventures abroad.




