Sept. 25, 2014

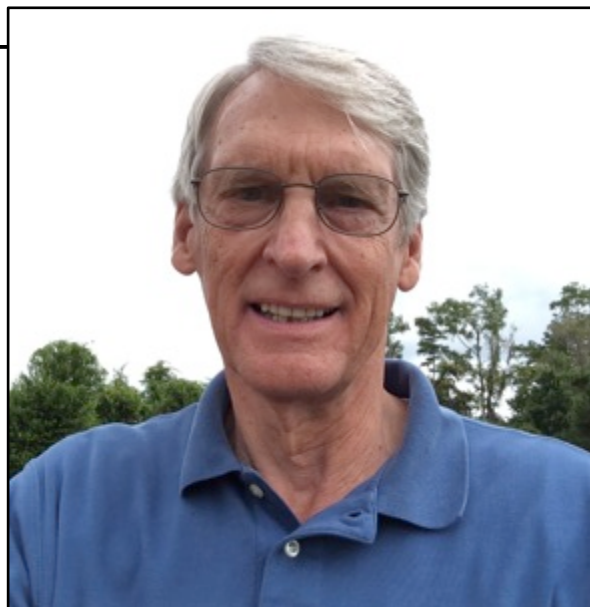
What was your first job? Morning Paperboy (*Minneapolis Tribune*)
