Roshini is a graduate of Edina High School, Boston College, and the University of Minnesota Law School.

Roshini was a finalist for a Rotary scholarship in the late '80s but lost out to a fellow Bloomington Rotary nominee. Her downfall was not knowing the Rotary motto during the interview phase. Her brother was nominated years later and Roshini took it upon herself to make sure he was prepared and knew the motto. He received a Rotary scholarship.

Roshini was a journalist and news anchor for many years in several different markets including Fargo, Des Moines, and Detroit. She said that rarely did she get nervous or intimidated about doing an interview with the exception of one time. It was shortly after Richard Prior died. She was working in Detroit and had to interview Patti Labelle. She was asked by the network to do a hard-hitting story on Richard Prior's death, when all of the Motown greats were in town to remember him and celebrate his life.

Roshini has helped many clients with their media relations and public relations, including the Vikings and the NFL, with all of their issues lately. In 2010 she wrote the book "Communicate That," which has sold out twice and is now on its third publication. She most recently wrote a column for Twin Cities Business magazine about Rotary's own Paul Mooty.

Tom Pirsch then thanked the speaker. And leff Ohe thanked our guests, visiting Rotarian, and our speaker and then adjourned the meeting.


