- 2. Grantees must agree to oversight for projects and finances where deemed appropriate by the Rotary Club of Edina Board of Directors.
- 3. It is preferable for all grant requests to have a Rotarian connection; preferably with the Rotary Club of Edina and/or its members.
- 4. For all grants, it is desirable that grants should be made in collaboration with other Rotary clubs, nongovernmental organizations, or similar organizations to maximize the scale, scope, and impact of the proposed project.
- 5. The Edina Rotary Foundation does not fund operating expense, land purchase, building construction, staff compensation (including interns), travel expenses, political activities/campaigns, and religious activities.
