

## Assumption of Risk Document

Hudson Daybreak Rotary utilizes the Camp St Croix facility for their meetings. For that reason, all members of Hudson Daybreak Rotary must abide by the stated rules of the YMCA of the North. If any member feels they can not abide by these rules, then such member should elect to utilize the club's virtual option until such rules no longer apply.

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

The YMCA of the North has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, YMCA of the North cannot guarantee that any patron will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, entry upon the premises of the YMCA of the North and any activities participated in could increase the risk of contracting COVID-19 for participants that attend the event.

By signing this agreement, you are acknowledging the following:

I acknowledge that I am voluntarily entering the premises of the YMCA of the North site for purposes of patronizing space for my personal benefit or the benefit of my organization, and the value of such benefit is sufficient consideration for my voluntary execution of this agreement.

I further acknowledge and voluntarily assume the risk that I, or my participants may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by patronizing YMCA of the North site and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at YMCA of the North site may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, employees, guests, vendors, agents, representatives, and any others present on the premises of the event. Additionally, I agree to follow all protocols outlined on page 2 of this document.

I further acknowledge and voluntarily agree to assume all the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my presence at the YMCA of the North or services performed at my request at the YMCA of the North site. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Business, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of YMCA of the North, its employees, agents, representatives, and Hudson Daybreak Rotary, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after my visit to the site.

This agreement shall remain in full force and effect at any and all locations of the Business operating under common ownership until the World Health Organization declares a completion of the worldwide pandemic related to COVID-19.

# Meeting Protocols

## Hudson Daybreak Rotary Phases:

- Phase I – no food or drink allowed in the RCU Center for meetings.
- Phase II – people may bring their own drink
- Phase III – Daybreak will provide coffee and people can bring their own drink
- Phase IV – Everything is Phase III is included plus a punch ticket will be offered for those that wish to purchase breakfast

## Things to keep in mind:

- Common spaces, meals, and equipment can be shared within a user/family group, and we ask for adequate distance (at least 6 ft) between each family/user group.
- Due to mandates from Minnesota and Wisconsin, masks are mandatory when you are indoors.

## Before:

- Prior to attending, you need to be able to answer these 4 questions.
  - Have you or anyone in your house traveled to another country in the past 14 days?
  - Within the last 14 days, has someone in your household tested positive for COVID-19?
  - Are you currently experiencing any symptoms of illness?
  - Do you have any concerns agreeing to follow the safety protocols around physical distancing?

If you answer yes to any of these questions, you should not attend.

## During:

- As part of our standard cleaning and sanitizing protocol, we will be sanitizing the space and all equipment after each use.
- We will be cleaning periodically through your event on a schedule for bathrooms, shared spaces and high-contact touchpoints.

## After:

- If you test positive within two weeks of your event, we ask that you contact your group leader who will contact us. We are required to report confirmed cases to the Wisconsin and Minnesota Department of Health.
