A. This will be the 21st tournament.

#### Q. How many teams participate?

A. 8 boys and 8 girls teams – both varsity and B squad.

#### Q. Where are the games played this year?

A. Varsity games will be played at Mayo Civic Auditorium and Regional Sports Center. B squad games will be played at the Regional Sports Center.

## Q. What does it cost the teams to play in the tournament?

A. Nothing, we do not have a registration fee and the Kahler Grand Hotel provides hotel rooms at a low cost which we pay. We have a dance for the teams the second night of the tournament with food and lots of door prizes.

#### Q. Has U.S. Bank always been a sponsor?

A. Yes. Their continued financial and staff support has been an important part of the success of the tournament.
