ROTARY FRIENDSHIP EXCHANGE TO SWEDEN - *Paul Olander – Rochester Rotary*

"In February, while at a Rotary meeting, I saw on the screen an announcement of an opportunity to participate in a Friendship Exchange to Sweden. I asked Lois about it—seriously doubting that anyone would consider an old reprobate like me. Lois, bless her heart, said, 'go ahead and fill out the application,' and I did so figuring that would be the end of it.

Well it wasn't. Only seven people, including two spouses that were not Rotarians, had volunteered to go, so my wife, Beverly, and I were committed. Two others joined us later to make a group of nine going from our District on May 12, 2007 to Copenhagen. The program was set up so that each couple would be the guests of three different Swedish families for three to five days each during a two week period.

Beverly and I have participated in Elderhostels both in this country and abroad and have also toured on our own, but we have never had such a wonderful trip. The friendships we made with the couples we lived with made our stay in Sweden a most rewarding experience."
