We have listed all of our Paul Harris Fellows in this issue. Fifty years ago, the Rotary Foundation came up with the idea of Paul Harris recognition. Although the concept of making \$1,000 gifts to the Foundation was slow in developing, by the early 1970s it began to gain popularity. The distinctive Paul Harris Fellow medallion, lapel pin, and attractive certificate have become highly respected symbols of a substantial financial commitment to the Rotary Foundation by Rotarians and friends around the world. In 2006, the number of Paul Harris Fellows reached the one million mark.

Any amount you can give is always appreciated. When your contributions total \$1,000 you can become a Paul Harris Fellow. You could also designate a family member, someone as a memorial contribution, a birthday, an anniversary or a friend you care for.

At our dinner honoring women in Rotary, **Tom Sitzer** presented **Barbara Banner** with a Paul Harris Award. Barb is a member of the Rotary Risers. Another interesting fact: Barb's father, **Past District Governor Ed Banner**, was our club's first Paul Harris Fellow. The total is now 356.
