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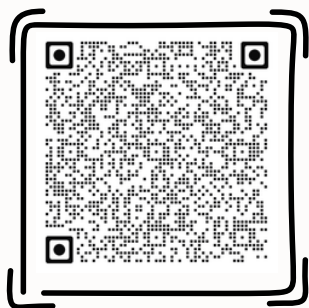
How to Sponsor

For the Riders!

In partnership with the Med City Meander, there are two signature relaxed tour options and a NEW 50+ mile route that will appeal to the faster, more adventurous crowd.

Route 1 - 15 mile loop that starts at Cascade Lake Park, visits a rest stop at Peace Plaza, and then heads back to Little Thistle Brewing for the after-party

Route 2 - 25 mile loop adds one additional rest stop at Silver Lake Firestation after the Peace Plaza stop, and then heading to Little Thistle Brewing

Route 3 - 50+ mile route starts and ends at Silver Lake Fire Station with a rest stop in Elgin, wrapping up with the after party at Little Thistle Brewing
