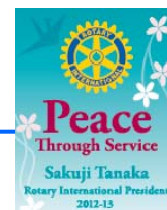

[Editor's note: The Stillwater noon club has sponsored Sara Damon and her students' "H2O for Life" project in Sudan several times. So this update from Sara may be of interest.]

November 26-28 Stillwater Junior High will host Alepho Deng, co-author of the Lost Boy of Sudan memoir "They Poured Fire On Us From The Sky". Alepho will provide a public presentation Tuesday, November 27th at 7 pm in the Stillwater Junior High School auditorium

Tickets are available in the SJHS Main Office or from Sara Damon for \$10 adult, \$5 student, cash or check to H2O For Life. Free tickets are available to those with financial need.

Please join us. If you have attended SJHS events with Lost Boys Benjamin, Benson or John in the past, you know their story of surviving civil war, forced migration, refugee life, resettlement in the U.S. and the resilience of the human spirit is incredibly powerful.

All proceeds will be directed to our H2O For Life project and African Soul, American Heart. Your ticket purchase helps bring clean, safe water to thousands, courtesy of Water For South Sudan, an NGO founded by Lost Boy Salva Dut.

In addition to Alepho's presentation, the evening will feature a selection of beautiful photos from Faces of South Sudan, a photo exhibit by Fargo, ND resident Debra Dawson. A full exhibit of Deb's photos will follow our event from November 28-December 22 at ArtReach St. Croix in downtown Stillwater. All are invited to the Faces of South Sudan photo exhibit opening from 6 to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, November 28 at ArtReach St. Croix.

A wide selection of books about the Lost Boys will be available for sale courtesy of Valley Bookseller, and we will also have exhibits and items for sale from H2O For Life, African Soul, American Heart and Books For Africa. A book signing reception with cake, coffee and juice will follow Alepho's presentation.
