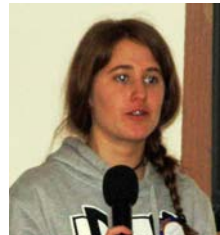

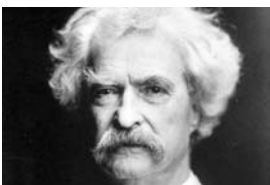

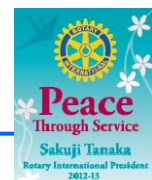

## Board Distributes Stillwater Rotary Funds

The 2013 **Stillwater Sampler** brought in over \$30,000 of revenue and had just over \$5,000 of expenses. In addition, over \$13,000 in earnings distributions from our foundation account with the St. Croix Valley Foundation are available for use.

**\$15,000** has been awarded to our spotlight partner at this year's **Stillwater Sampler**, District 834's **Partnership Plan**. The \$15,000 will be doubled through a matching grant from the Hubbard Foundation and go to Stillwater Area High School's new Fab Lab, an integral part of the school's S.T.E.M. curriculum. We are excited to be able to make a significant gift towards our area youths' education and were overjoyed with the success of the **Sampler** this year, due in large part to teaming up with the Partnership Plan and their supporters. The board has also approved the distribution of the remaining \$23,000 as follows:

**\$11,150** in grants were made to the following organizations (minimum of \$500 each): A Place of Grace, American Cancer Society/Relay for Life, ArtReach Alliance, Canvas Health, Catholic Youth Camp, Community Thread/Transportation Summit, Hope Adoption, H2O for Life, Lakeview Hospital Prescription Fund, Lutheran Mideast Development, River Valley Riders, Stillwater Area High School Senior Class Party, Store to Door, Tom Scheuerman Youth Fund of SCVF Sponsorship, Trinity Lutheran Church/M meal Packing Event, Unseen Angels, Washington County Historic Courthouse, Youth Service Bureau.

**\$2,000** in scholarships to be awarded to 2 seniors from Stillwater Area High School.

**\$3,000** awarded to 3 District and Global grants, **\$1,000 each**. The actual projects are: Infant Medical Assistance – Argentinean Republic, Books for Africa, and Street Girls Aid – Ghana, West Africa; all partnering with other clubs in our District/Region.

Finally, the board has approximately \$7,000 remaining in a discretionary account. A challenge will be forthcoming regarding partial use of these funds.
