HOST FAMILIES NEEDED 2013-2014

Thomas, age 16, is from France and enjoys computer science, programming and robotics. He is described as friendly, responsible and independent. He lives at home with his parents and younger sister. While in Minnesota, he will attend Stillwater Area High School.

Our local Rotary clubs are looking for 2-3 host families to host Thomas for about 3-31/2 months each during his stay. He will arrive on August 22, 2013 and will depart sometime in July, 2014. Host families may include couples or single adults with or without children in the home. Rotary membership is not required. All potential hosts must be interviewed and pass background checks. Rotary provides ongoing support to the students and host families through a dedicated counselor, Youth Exchange Committee members and well-defined Youth Exchange program rules. The Rotary clubs offer additional support in the form of a monthly stipend to the student, basic cell phone, paying for school lunches and certain Host families provide normal room expenses. and board in a safe, loving and comfortable home environment. It is not necessary that the host family speak French, as the students are eager to improve their English skills.
