**GETTING TO KNOW OUR MEMBERS:**

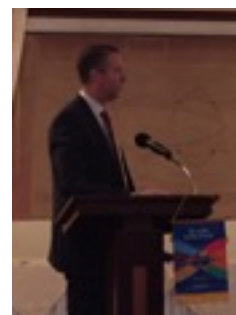
Doug Wolff is a native Stillwater resident, has been a dentist here for 18 years and a Rotarian for the same amount of time. He is a past president of our club and he is a member of the Minnesota Board of Dentistry.

**PROGRAM:**



Kendra Lohmen is in charge of Marketing and Operations of Bluestone Physician Services. Bluestone was started by Dr. Todd Stivland living in Duluth. He came to Stillwater in 2006 and founded after starting a practice in Duluth of visiting the disabled and geriatric population at their homes. He moved the idea to group homes, assisted living and memory care units because of the greater access to support medical staffs at those facilities. The medical teams provide on average monthly visits and funds come from the insurance providers billed as a normal office call.

Today they have 4000 patients in the geriatric area and 1000 disabled. They have expanded out side of Minnesota to the adjoining states and are now in Orlando Florida. Did you know that there are more assisted living beds in Tampa Bay Florida then the states of Minnesota and Wisconsin combined? It is preventative mode that is strongly supported by Insurance companies. They have 200 employees, 50 MD and PA's combined. They are especially proud of Bluestone Bridge, an on-line communication system that keeps the patient, their family and Bluestone in constant communication.
