#### **GETTING TO KNOW OUR MEMBERS**:

Justin Bonestroo has been a Rotarian for 9 years, a former basketball standout at Stillwater and an attorney in town.

#### PROGRAM:



Justin Bonestroo introduced Pete Orput, County Attorney, who gave a passionate talk on Drug Abuse in Washington County. In an iconic statement, Pete said that drug abuse is one area where he "cannot jail his way out the problem." It does not work, after serving time, they are right back at it. The results of their survey, which by the way youth are more then willing to be forthcoming, youth from as low as 8th, 9th and 10th grades are using alcohol, marijuana, or prescription drugs specifically opiates. 50% for 10th grade, 25% for 9th grade. 65,000 people have died from overdose, 16 in our county. What happens...doctor prescribes an opiate for pain and within 8 days of use the person is on their way to addiction. And then what happens is they can get opium at half the price from Mexico. It is important for parents to get into the cell phone or bedroom of a child when they are suspicious of addiction. The problem is sufficiently wide spread that police carry Narcan, an antidote to overdose of an opiate. There is a state law, called Steve's law, in Minnesota that gives immunity to prosecution a person who believes someone is in danger of dving from an overdose calls 911. Be careful of realtors who are known to enter a house they are showing and steal prescription drugs. Finally, in Washington DC a state attorney general successfully sued big Pharma for detailing doctors on using an opiate designed for end of life pain control for ordinary use and won. If you are having problem, call Arba-Della and Family Means, they have treatment contacts.
