Bob McDowell is currently Exec. Dir. of Learning and Innovation for Stillwater Area Schools. He has been in public education for 21 years as teacher, technology coordinator and principal. He is a professor at Bethel and holds a Doctorate from St. Mary's Univ. of MN. He began his college career at U. of Wis. Stout. He is married to Suzanne and they have 3 children.



PROGRAM:



Bob McDowell introduced Mr. Rob Bach, Principal Stillwater Area High School. Bob holds a bachelor's degree in Chemistry/Education from St. Olaf College and a master's degree in Education from Winona State University. He has taught at Woodbury H.S. and was volley ball coach at Park H.S.

He talked about STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) at our high school. There is a project called "Lead the Way" which is a speciality engineering program where the student can take 5 classes, Intro. to Eng., Practice of Eng. , Digital Electronics and Civil Engineering and Architecture and finally how to build anything. The latter best describes the program which is accredited.

The skill set is expressed in a Laboratory much like the old Industrial Arts but 3 D printers and CAD software, making little but useful objects like a cell phone cover with a place to wind your ear plugs shaped like the pony emblem. Fascinating.

The courses are electives but great training.
