STRIVE Presentation by Brent Voight

What is STRIVE: Students Taking a Renewed Interest in the Value of Education

Goal: to encourage, inspire and broaden perspective

Stillwater Sunrise Rotary is the sponsor of STRIVE at Stillwater Area High School

-provide STRIVE Coordinator

-provide annually \$5000-6500 for scholarships to STRIVE students

-purchase lunch or refreshments for each STRIVE meeting

- funds supplies and other needs to help with recruiting students/mentors
- Outlook for 2016-2017
 - student recruitment: 10th grade academy
 - partnership with AVID (Advancement via Individual Determination)
- New STRIVE structure - will meet the 3rd and 5th Friday of each month from 11:36-1:10 (94 minutes)
 - student to mentor ratio of 5:2 (60+students, 25-30 mentors)
 - team approach to mentors/students
 - team competition metrics: Academic, Attendance, Community Service
- Brents vision:
 - mentors & financial commitment to come from all three Stillwater-area Rotary clubs
 - STRIVE sponsor and year-end STRIVE banquet
 - Significant and impactful scholarships given to many STRIVE students
 - each year 2-4 STRIVE students attend Camp RYLA and Camp Enterprise
 - speaker/panelist network built around careers the students want to know about
- How can Rotary be a part
 - be a mentor
 - 90 minutes, one time per month on average
 - dates: 9/16, 9/30, 10/??, 11/18, 12/16, 1/20, 2/17, 3,17, 4/21, 5/19
 - background check with school (\$15 for 3 years)
 - youth protection training (online) with Rotary 3 years
 - be a speaker or panelist
 - be willing to meet or be interviewed by a STRIVE student about your career path
 - Advocate for STRIVE when speaking with school officials and community leaders
