**GETTING TO KNOW OUR MEMBERS:**

Lynda introduced Del. Del Peterson grew up on a dairy farm in Windstorm, MN with four brothers., he is a lawyer, graduating from William Mitchell and an MBA from St. Thomas. He has worked at Control Data, The Space Center, Target and Financial Advisor for Edward Jones from where he retired in 2011. He and his wife Marilyn have traveled to all the countries of the world except Antarctica. Del's hobby is fixing around the house.



**PROGRAM:**



Our speaker Gary Warren, is a neighbor of Del's, is on the senior planning staff of the Metropolitan Airports Commission. He noted that the Main Airport (MSP) has just completed a \$600 million improvement in the runways with the airport now sporting 600 miles of runway. He is a civil engineer himself. Has served on advisory committees in the industry including LAX.

Our MSP began in 1917 with a landing area on grass in the middle of a car raceway. It is 2100 acres small by most standards actually for example approx. 1/10 size of the Denver Airport. In 1930 the first terminal was built. The commission consists of 12 appointees by the Gov. and the Mayors of St. Paul and Minneapolis. All small aircraft are placed on the surrounding small airports like Holman Field and Lake Elmo. The expansion of Terminal 2 now of itself includes 4 million passages in a year. MSP is 13th in the nation in landings and takeoffs and 16th in passenger traffic. Because it is a hub, we have many transcontinental flights including the latest, a not-stop flight to Rome. We have 155 such flights each year. They are in the middle of adding another parking ramp and a hotel/convention center. The only domestic airline that is not at MSP is JetBlue.

In answer to a question, a typical runway is 6 Ft deep with all its' foundational ground.
