We needed to get to the heart of issues by changing the culture. In Nicaragua we are doing just that. With the help of another non-profit and in cooperation with a local Rotary Club we are working in the Masaya region. Dave told many stories of the frustration of following through on projects which required the cooperation of 3 mayors which took forever finally requiring the intervention of villagers and

Rotary and Dave to get them moving. They are solving their own problems, working with Rotary and it is moving along but not without hurdles. They have an ingrained culture of expecting help from the outside that they need and are overcoming.
