

Lowell Inn Banquet Center Projector Connection (as of March 2016)

Input: the only video input to the projector is VGA



This port can be found behind the left curtain on the wall with the screen.

Output Device Options:

1) PC Laptop with VGA output



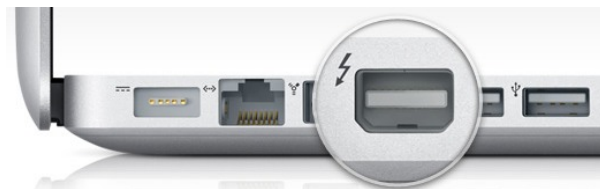
This is the easiest connection as it only involves one cable: VGA cable

2) PC Laptop with HDMI output



Plug the small HDMI to VGA adaptor into the laptop and then the VGA cable to projector input

3) Macbook with Mini Display Port



Plug the Mac Mini Display Port adaptor into the Mac and then the VGA cable to projector input

4) Chromebook with HDMI output



Plug the small HDMI to VGA adaptor into the Chromebook and then the VGA cable to projector input

5) Tablet with HDMI output



Plug the small HDMI to VGA adaptor into the tablet and then the VGA cable to projector input

NOTE: We do not yet have a USB video connection option. VGA, HDMI or Mac mini display port are the only output options.

Sound:

A VGA cable does not carry audio (even if you are connecting to your HDMI port). Therefore, if you need sound with your presentation, use the Speaker cable from your device's headphone port to the speaker input in the wall next to the VGA input

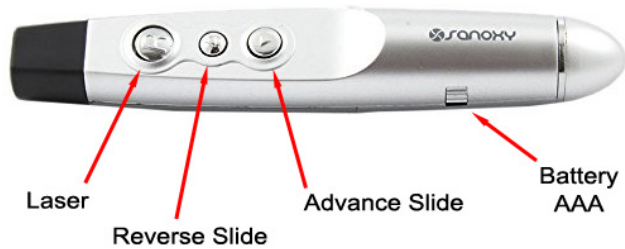


Sunrise Rotary will provide the projector and all cables and adaptors shown above.

The presenter is required to bring his or her own output device (PC laptop, Macbook, Chromebook or tablet).

Presentation “Clicker”

Sunrise Rotary also has available a wireless presentation page up/down “clicker”. This device has two pieces. Plugs the one part into your open USB port (plug and play – no install necessary). The other part is the clicker. See the diagram below for instructions. In addition, this device is typically stored with the battery out so you will need to slide open the compartment and insert a single AAA battery which should also be available in the device case. The use of this device is highly recommended, as it will give you flexibility to move around during the presentation.



WiFi
