

Rotary “Service Above Self” Award

The Waseca Rotary Club is accepting nominations for the annual “Service Above Self” Award. A person interested in submitting a nomination for this award can find a nomination form on the Waseca Rotary Club website home page under “Home Page Download Files” at portal.clubrunner.ca/5643/ and either completing the form electronically and emailing it to Dr. Rodney Kolpin at kolpin1@mchsi.com or to Paul Dressler at paul.dressler@mchsi.com, or printing the form and then mailing the completed form to Waseca Rotary Club, 123 6th Ave. S.E., Waseca, MN 56093. The nomination forms must be received by November 1st for the nominees to be considered for the current award year.

The award criteria includes the following: the award is to be given to a living person; the nominee should be someone who has exhibited an extraordinary level of volunteerism in one or two areas of service that is separate from their employment and/or business pursuits; the services performed have contributed to the welfare of the community and the services have been performed for an extended period of time.

The selection committee will then meet and select the recipient by November 15th. The Rotary chairperson presents the award to the recipient at the annual Chamber Community Awards Banquet held in January.

The recipient will receive a plaque to commemorate their achievement, and they will have the honor of a \$500.00 cash contribution made to a community cause of their choosing that is approved by the Rotary selection committee and donated in their name by the Waseca Rotary Club.
