Rotary Youth Exchange Scholarships are made possible by the generosity of our overseas partners and the LOCAL ROTARY CLUBS IN DISTRICT 6220 (Northern Wisconsin and the U.P. of Michigan). Qualified applicants must be ages 15-18.5 at the time of departure and meet Rotary International standards for academics and behavior. This scholarship covers Room, Board, Tuition, and a Monthly Stipend for one academic year while abroad. The student/family pays a flat fee (\$6,500) which covers orientations (Oct/Feb/July before you leave the USA), airfare, insurance, visa, Rotary blazer, books, in-country language camps (where required), and other material.
