Dear Elmbrook School District Senior,

Congratulations on your upcoming graduation!

Now it is time to consider the next step for your education, and the Elmbrook Rotary Club wants to help.

The Elmbrook Rotary Club is a community service group that supports numerous non-profit organizations, both locally and internationally. Additionally, it has been our privilege to support the Elmbrook School District with scholarship opportunities for Central and East graduating seniors. Elmbrook Rotary Club has chosen to limit our scholarships to seniors who have been enrolled in the AVID program at their high school. We view a graduating AVID participant as having demonstrated individual determination to honor the AVID contract and to have fulfilled the requirements to become college and career ready. We wish to recognize that effort with our scholarships.

The scholarships will be awarded to three deserving students each year. Two of the scholarships are \$1,000 (each) per year for four years to seniors going to an accredited four-year college or university. The third scholarship is \$1,000 per year for two years to a senior going to a two-year college or technical school. All three scholarships are limited to AVID participants and require full-time enrollment at the school of the recipient's choice.

We look forward to having seniors like yourself complete the accompanying application (a fillable PDF) and submit it electronically. DO NOT SUBMIT A HARD COPY TO STUDENT SERVICES! It is essential that the application be filled out in its entirety and all necessary signatures or sign-offs be completed.

<u>All applications must be electronically submitted by April 16, 2021</u>. To complete the application successfully, it should be opened from within Adobe Acrobat Reader DC and all applicable fields filled. The Elmbrook Rotary Club will review the applications and select 6-8 applicants for an interview that will determine the recipients. Winners will be notified prior to their school's awards ceremony. Once again, congratulations on your upcoming graduation and best wishes for your future success!
