



What is Rotary?

Rotary International is a volunteer organization of business and professional leaders who provide humanitarian service, and help to build goodwill and peace in the world. There are approximately 1.2 million Rotary club members belonging to 33,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas. Founded in Chicago in 1905, Rotary celebrated 100 years of service in 2005. The Rotary Foundation has awarded more than \$2.1 billion in grants, which are administered at the local level by Rotary clubs.

What is the purpose of Rotary?

Rotary clubs exist to improve communities through a range of humanitarian, intercultural and educational activities. Clubs advance international understanding by partnering with clubs in other countries. Rotary also encourages high ethical standards in all vocations.

Rotary serves peace.

In an effort to educate tomorrow's peacemakers and ambassadors, rotary supports six Rotary Centers for International Studies based at prestigious universities in five countries. The program, launched in 2002, provides masters's level education in conflict resolution to classes of up to 60 Rotary World Peace Scholars a year.







Rotary serves humanity.

In 1985, Rotary International created Polio Plus - a program to immunize all the world's children against polio. To date, Rotary has contributed more than \$700 million toward eradicating this disease, a figure which will rise to more than \$850 million by the time the world is certified polio-free.

These funds provide polio vaccine, operational support, medical personnel, laboratory equipment and educational materials for health workers and the public. Rotary members have helped immunize over two billion children in 122 countries.

With its community based network worldwide, Rotary is the volunteer arm of the global partnership dedicated to eradicating polio. Rotary volunteers assist in vaccine delivery, social mobilization and logistical help in cooperation with the national health ministries, the World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF, and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control.
