

This week's program facilitated deeper conversations to discover the 'traditions that connect us' (shoutout Ryan Daniels for that slogan)


AND!! Our own table member, Natraj, won the lucky prize for dinner at Saffron.

This can be a great tool to share club events and news with your friends, family members, and other colleagues who are already connected to you on Facebook.


Facebook content will mostly be used to build curiosity among the community.




## How to Engage




### How to Tag Us

Rotary Club of Milwaukee will then appear as either light blue or bolded in black in your post.







### **Creative Elements**

And if you need a specific CONNECTING logo, give Aaron a call.














- Connect with others! Like, share, and comment on posts not only from the RCM account, but with other Rotarians too.

- <u>Click here to subscribe</u> to our event calendar to add all upcoming speakers, tours, volunteer events and socials to your personal calendar.




## Rotary and You

#### **Our Role:**

We post to introduce new Rotarians, tell the public of the consistent good work our members accomplish, weekly top-notch speakers, exclusive access to behind-the-scenes tours, lively social events, and more.

#### **Your Role:**

You are the driving force behind Rotary's online presence. While we can post all we want about how great we are, (and we are), your friends, family and colleagues online are going to take your word for it, not ours.





## Social Media Policy

#### **Encouraged**:



- Follow the "4-way test" when posting:
  - Is it the truth?
  - o Is it fair to all concerned?
  - Will it build goodwill and better friendships?
  - Will it be beneficial to all concerned?
- Engage in discussions on Rotary topics and interact with each other.
- Celebrate the programs, activities, friendships and more available through Rotary.

#### **Prohibited:**



- Messages that are inconsistent with Rotary values of service, fellowship, diversity, integrity and leadership.
- Messages that are religious, political, sexist, ethnically or racially offensive, or obscene messages are not permitted.
- Solicitation of donations for non-Rotary events.
- Solicitation of business.
