



What does it mean that the Rotary Club of Milwaukee is a “solicitation-free zone?”

The Rotary Club of Milwaukee is all about CONNECTING and building relationships.

- It is the place to be to expand your professional and personal connections among a diverse group of over 350 business and community leaders at meetings, social events and community projects. You are also part of a global network of more than 1.4 million men and women.
- It is the place to be if you want to learn about issues that impact our community and our world through speakers, presenters and live forums.
- It is the place to be if you committed to Milwaukee and want to collaborate with dynamic “People of Action” to create lasting change locally and globally.

At the same time, it has been a long-standing expectation that Rotarians do not actively solicit one another for business or charitable donations. The membership directory should not be used for “cold calling”.

If a Rotarian is running for office, similar constraints apply—no campaigning, distributing literature or nomination papers, or asking for donations or votes at Rotary events.

Although there are many examples of business and donor relationships cemented through Rotary, these relationships are developed over time. As we get to know and trust our fellow Rotarians, it becomes natural to want to work together, to support one another.
