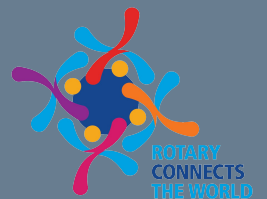

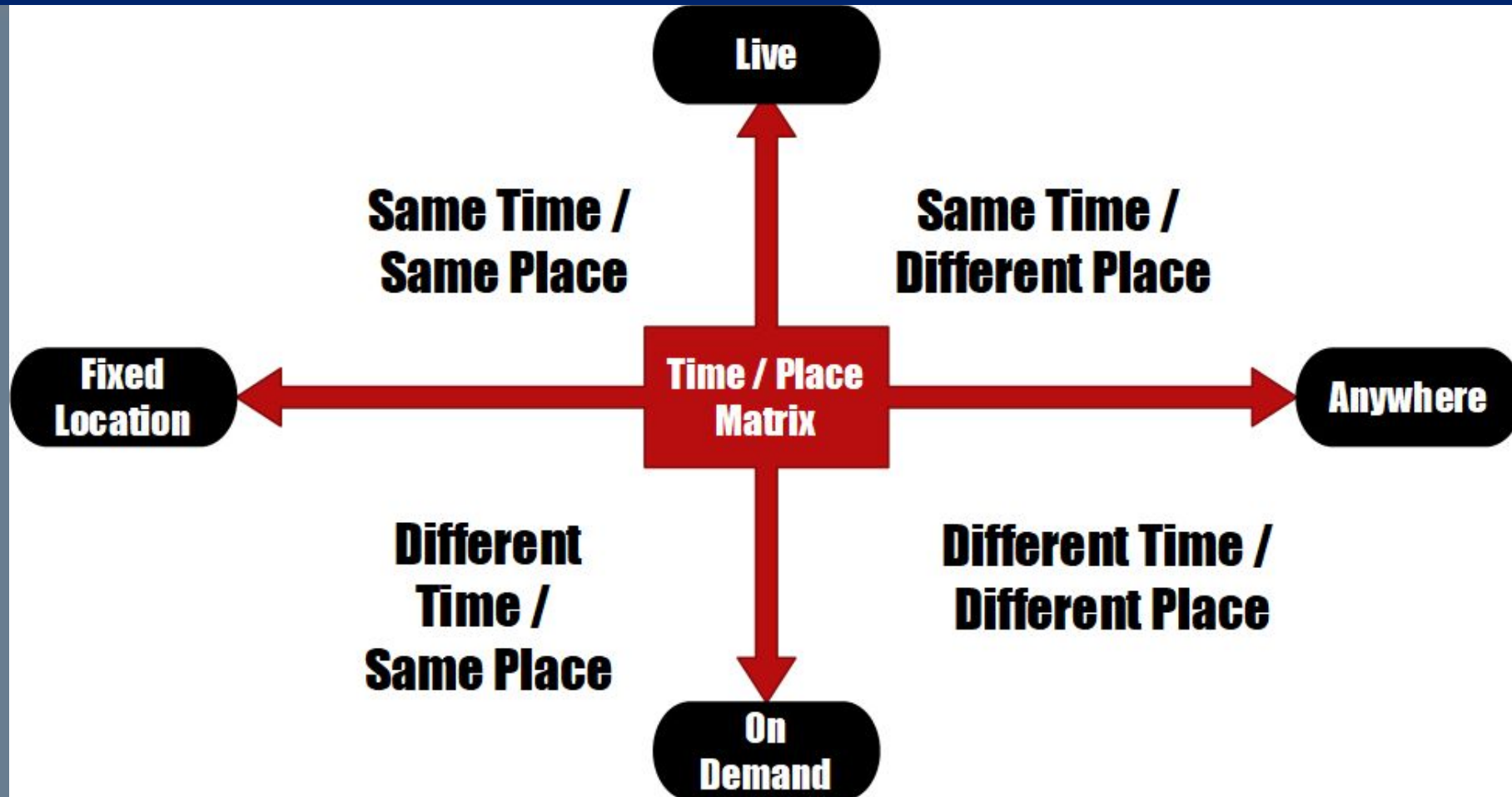
# Introduction

- Isolated and Rotary - opposite ends of a spectrum

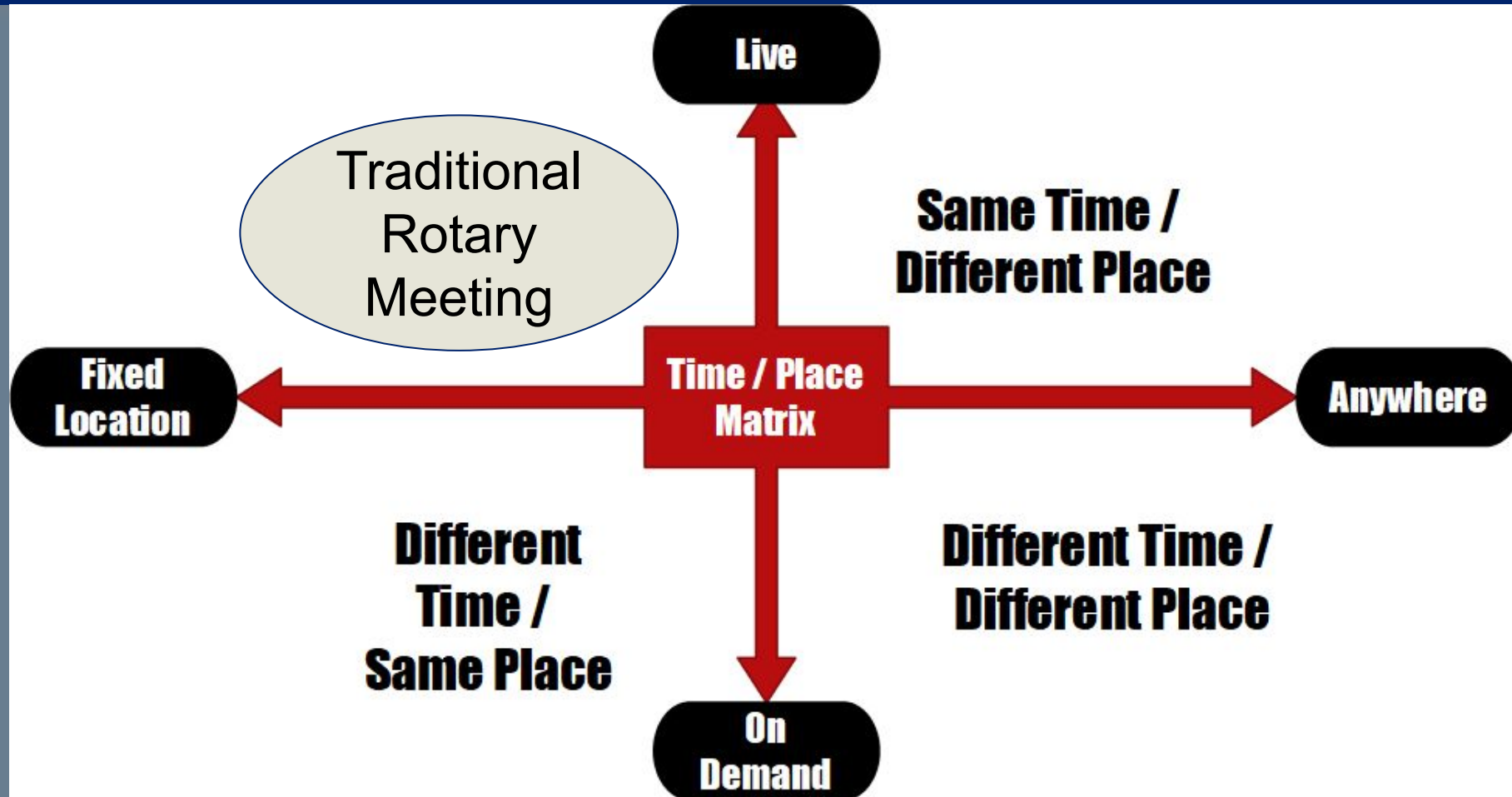

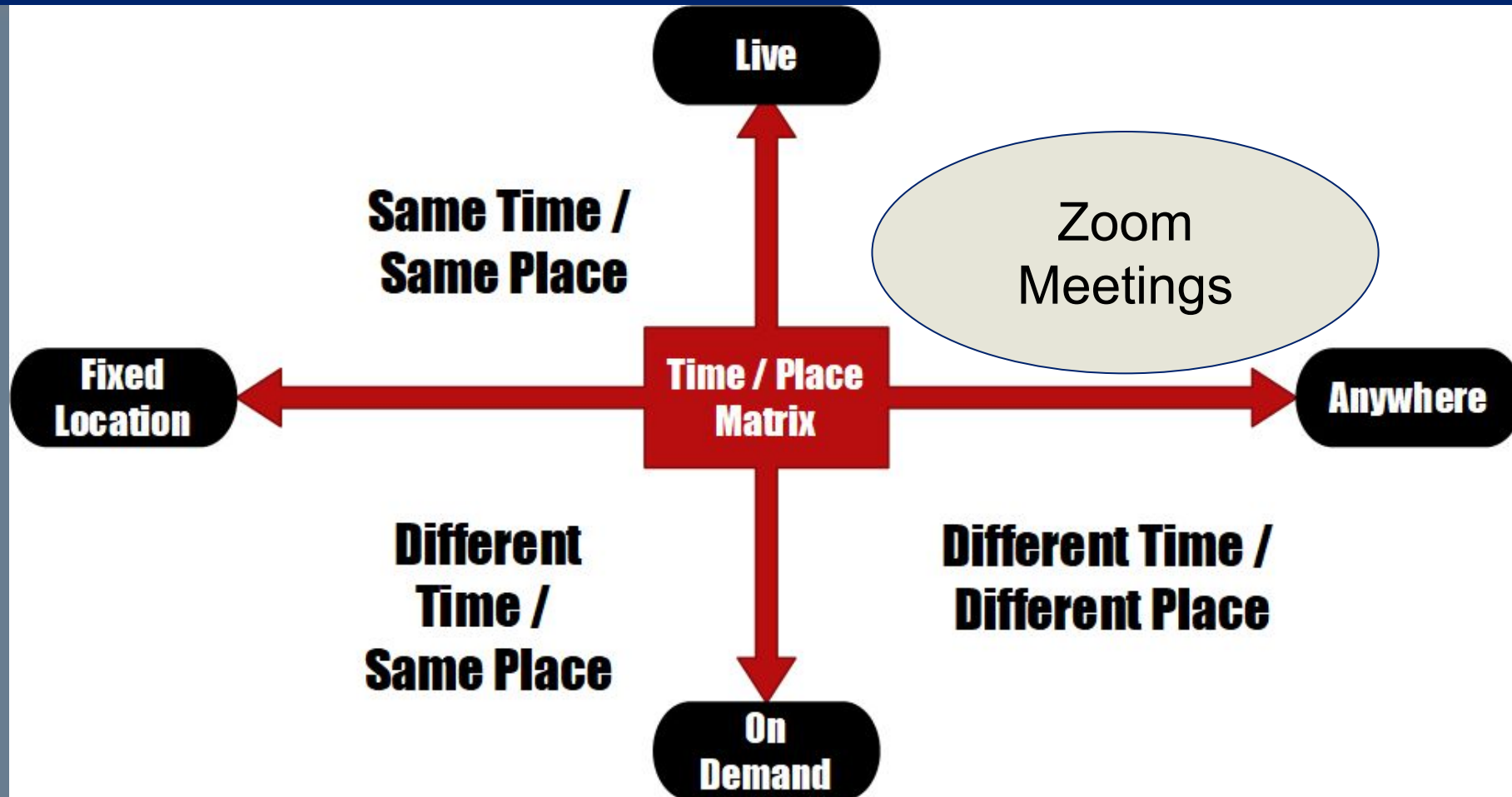

# Zoom Meetings, How to do a Rotary Club Meeting

- You need the software, Clubs - Single Host License \$120
- Participants need to install the Zoom app on their device
  - Do not need license
  - Available for PC, Macintosh, iPhones, Android phones and tablets
- Train participants on use (doing this today)
- Speaker should not be the Host
- Should use Co-Host - acting as Sergeant at Arms for technical
- Can share screens, powerpoint etc
- Manager Participants, Chat

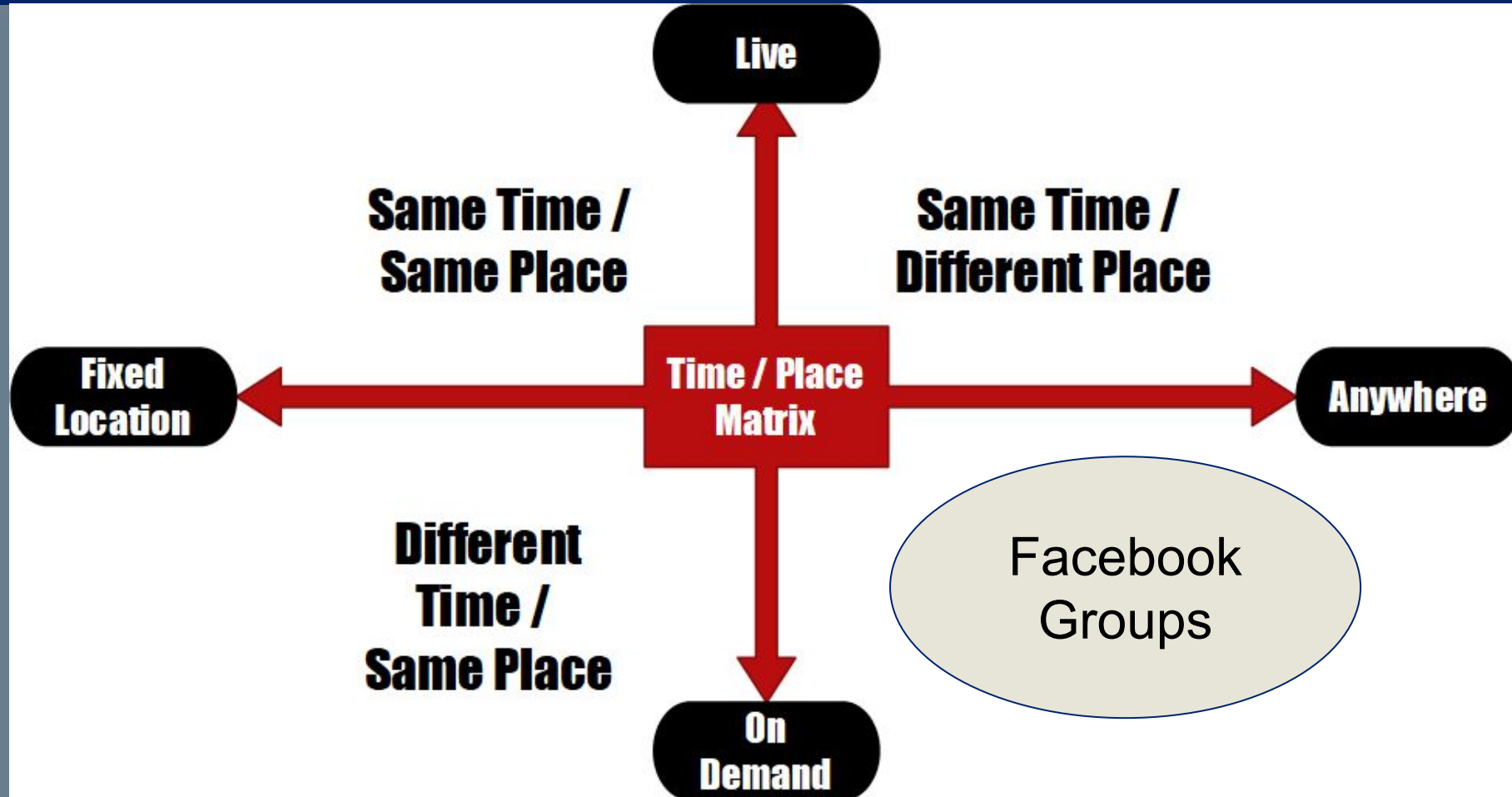

# Facebook Live (Different Place - Same Time)

- Live video streaming service that lets anyone broadcast using their Facebook account or Page
- Broadcasters can select who on Facebook can view broadcast and recording
- Viewer can comment in real-time
- Limited to single camera
  - Be.Live
    - Solo, Face-to-Face, and Talk Show formats
    - Scheduling
  - Live Reacting, StreamYard, and OBS Studio

# Facebook Groups (Different Place - Different Time)

- Different from a Facebook Page - a profile for your organization
- Three Types of Groups: Open, Closed, Secret
- Group members can
  - Notify others of upcoming events
  - Plan future events/meetings
  - Share posts and photos with members

# Socialize

- Zoom - maximum 100 people
- Skype - maximum 50 people
- Facebook Messenger - maximum 50 people
- Google Duo - maximum 8 people\*
- WhatsApp - maximum 4 people
- Group FaceTime - maximum 32 people (Apple Only)
