

**Waukesha Rotary Club
Rotary International
Corporate Member Program
Program Implementations**

Financial Obligations: The financial obligations of an eligible corporation will be as follows:

- Initiation Fee – The processing fee per corporation, for each designee, will be the same as for an individual active member (currently \$40/person). This is due at the time of submitting application. This covers cost of membership pin & badge.
- RI Dues/District Dues/ Club Dues – Each designee will be charged the same rate as an individual active membership (currently \$85/quarter/person). First Quarterly dues will be submitted with initial application.
- Meal/Beverage Costs – The eligible corporation will be billed for the cost of one designee (currently \$16.00/week) unless meeting is not scheduled that week. If more than one designee attends the same meeting, the corporation will be billed the current lunch rate on the following quarterly billing.
- Change of Membership Status from Corporate Designee to Active: Any designee seeking to change from designee of a corporate membership to individual active membership will be billed on a prorated basis for both dues and lunch fees. The eligible corporation can re-assign its designee.
- Participate in Annual Club Fundraisers including Creative Fundraising - funds are contributions to Rotary Charitable Funds.
- Option weekly donation at meetings: birthdays, anniversary, member news
- Optional Participation in Polio Plus monthly raffle drawings-funds donated to Rotary International Polio Plus.
- Optional Contribution to The Rotary Foundation: Donations to Rotary International Foundation, Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY). Club members will be encouraged to donate \$100/ year individually. Paul Harris Fellowships would belong to the individual designees once \$1,000 has been donated.

Approval: A corporate entity or organization may apply for membership in the Waukesha Rotary Club subject to meeting the current application process for individual active membership.

Designees: Once an entity becomes an eligible corporate member through the current application process:

- The corporation may appoint up to four people to be its designees

Changing Designees: The eligible corporation can change any of its designees at times if notification of the change is made to the Club Administrator of the Waukesha Rotary Club.

Rotary International Registration: Each designee will be listed as an official member of the Waukesha Rotary Club and will be noted in the roster that they are designees of the named eligible corporation.

Classification: The classification of the eligible corporation and its designees will be assigned by the Waukesha Rotary Club, according to the classification limits set forth in the RI Constitution, Article 5, Section 2(b).

Inductions: A corporate member designee will be formally inducted into the club at a designated regular Rotary meeting and receive Rotary Pin and Badge the same as an individual active membership.

Badges: Membership Badge will be ordered for member as part of the initiation fee to be worn at Rotary meetings identifying the member by name.

Committees: All members are required to join and participate in at least one committee

Fundraisers: All members are required to work a minimum of one shift per fundraising event and sell or purchase tickets for fundraising events.

Votes and Quorum: For the purpose of general meetings and club matters, each designee in attendance will be allowed one vote, the same way as an individual active member.

Holding Office: In keeping with the tradition of the Waukesha Rotary Club, the Nominating Committee of the club will determine the slate of officers/board of directors. Each designee, as an individual, can hold any office to which the designee is elected. The slate of proposed nominees will be reviewed by the current Officers and Directors of the Waukesha Rotary Club before going before the club at large for approval.

Conversion: A designee of the eligible corporation, while still an employee of the eligible corporation, may convert to an individual member of the Waukesha Rotary Club. The individual designee would notify Club Administrator of Change of Status to update membership

Bulletin and Communication: Each designee will receive a weekly email from the Club Administrator regarding upcoming meetings and/or events, so it is important we have a current email on file. This will also include the monthly schedule for roles as Greeter, Share Rotary, Pledge of Allegiance, Invocation and 4 Way Test

Receipt of *The Rotarian* Magazine: Each designee will receive a subscription to *The Rotarian*, as part of membership

Public Liability Cover: corporate member designees will be included under the respective club liability insurance while participating in any approved club activities or projects, if applicable as provided by Rotary International.

Participation in Youth Activities: corporate member designees are expected to abide by all restrictions, policies, and procedures with respect to club activities involving youth.

Change in Status including Termination of Membership or Transfer to Another Club: It is the responsibility of the designee to report change of membership status to Club

Administrator. The change in status or termination of the membership of a designee will be brought before the Board of Directors of the Waukesha Rotary Club for approval.
