ROTARY CLUB OF SAGINAW COMMITTEES

All of our service projects are championed by one or more of our committees. Since we are a service club, our expectation is that you will find a committee to align yourself with. Our committees generally align to one or more of Rotary's Areas of Focus. Please find one that suits your passion!

• <u>Executive Committee</u>-Club officers - develops goals, objectives, and strategic priorities for our club.



- <u>Community Needs</u> helps to support local organizations within our community, including helping with environmental tasks (Annual Watershed Cleanup).
- <u>Fellowship and Service</u> participates in community-wide events to promote Rotary and our motto,
 "Service Above Self".
- <u>Focus on Youth</u> engages youth and encourages positive behaviors through involvement with Rotary. Promotes and supports the best interests of youth in our club and community.
- <u>Fundraising</u> develops and promotes Rotary events to create awareness of and generate income for community needs and Rotary initiatives.
- <u>Member and Social Networking</u> orients and integrates Rotary members in Club happenings and events.
- Rotary Club of Saginaw Foundation is a separate 501(c)(3) charitable corporation established so that Rotarians can make tax deductible contributions that would benefit the Saginaw area and other Rotary causes. (Participation on this committee is limited.)
- \sim Programs handles all aspects of the weekly programming, including scheduling speakers. $\stackrel{\bigcirc}{=}$
- <u>Spirit of Rotary</u> identifies individuals within our community who represent the ideals of Rotary and selects candidates to receive the Spirit of Rotary Award.
- Stewards of Rotary maintains the history of the Club, reaches out to members who may be suffering from long-term or debilitating illnesses, and partners younger members with more senior members as mentors.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

- Our annual dues are \$225. Fees are pro-rated, with our fiscal year beginning in July. Payment options for dues may be available on an as-needed basis.
- Every year we host 3 fundraisers: Saginaw on Stage music event, a Rotary Raffle and our Swing into Action Charity Golf Outing. Our "ask" is that you help sell tickets or purchase and donate/give away tickets for the Saginaw on Stage event and the Rotary Raffle. For the Golf Outing, our "ask" is that you help to solicit a sponsorship of at least \$100. All proceeds generated go toward supporting areas of need within our community.
- During the year, we will "ask" for your support in helping with our Eradicate Polio Initiative and other causes supported through the Rotary International Foundation.
- In addition to our international initiatives, we may also "ask" for support for other Rotary Club of Saginaw Foundation initiatives such as the CMU College of Medicine Foundation fundraiser to help provide scholarships to medical interns staying in the area, and also to the Camp Rotary Foundation which provides opportunities to deserving youth in Saginaw County. (Both optional)
- During weekly meetings, your weekly lunch is selected and paid for by you directly with the Saginaw Club. Optional 50/50 tickets are available weekly and must be purchased with cash.
