At the close of the 2021-22 academic year, we announced that Taylor Frish (Keystone High School) was the recipient of the District 6600 STRIVE Renewable Scholarship. We sat down with Taylor to learn about how her first year of college was going.

Which school did you decide to attend following high school? I am currently attending the Ohio State Agricultural Technical Institute (ATI) where I major in Animal Sciences

How did your first semester (fall 2022) at ATI go? Throughout the first semester of this school year, I have received a cumulative 3.4 GPA and have been dedicating most of my hours to studying and socializing with other people with similar majors as mine. In fact, next year I plan on attending the Ohio State University (main campus) where I will continue my education in Animal Science in hopes of one day pursuing my dreams of becoming a veterinarian.

Rotary Responds - can you help?

East Palestine, Ohio is home to only about 5,000 residents. It is in Appalachia and it is not a wealthy area. Many who evacuated their homes initially have not yet returned - they are afraid of the long term effects of the vinyl chloride that has leached into the soil. Many families left their homes with just the clothes on their backs, not knowing that they would stay away for this long.

The cleanup of this area will take years. The long term ramifications of this accident are unclear and many are worried about their health.

DG Michelle Charles has created a donation portal on their district website. She is working closely with the Rotary Club of East Palestine as well as leaders in the community in order to get the funds where they are needed most.

The impact of the earthquakes in both Turkey and Syria is devastating. Two weeks in and ShelterBox aid has arrived in Turkey and Syria, including essential items such as tents, blankets, mattresses, and winter coats for children, with more on the way. The items will help people survive through this ongoing nightmare, protecting them from the winter weather, preventing the spread of disease, and providing some privacy, as they get back on their feet.

The Port Clinton Rotary Club and its members are working together to raise \$2000 for Shelter Box in response to these tragic events. The club is offering to match any member donations, up to \$1000. Port Clinton Rotary Club is challenging the other clubs within our District to run a similar campaign within their clubs. Let's make a positive impact in this area as well.
