

Flex Membership

- One primary member is registered with RI and counted toward the club roster.
- Up to 4 additional members can be officially designated to attend in the place of, or in addition to, the primary member. The primary member and designees must undergo the same election and induction process as classic members. For club purposes, all flex members will be considered Rotarians.
- Dues are to be tiered depending on the number of additional members.
 - 1-2 additional members: \$100+ regular dues [this is a total cost, not per individual]
 - 3-4 additional members: \$150+ regular dues [ditto]
- All participation will be counted on the attendance of the primary member. (unless dacdb allows otherwise?)
- The primary member will be billed quarterly for a meal per meeting to make it easy for flex members to attend.
 - When more than one representative in a flex membership is in attendance, they must pay for any additional meals/events.
- Only the primary member is eligible for board service and voting.
- When club members are asked to participate in initiatives, such as selling tickets or Every Rotarian Every Year, such obligations are asked of the primary member but may be shared by the flex members.
- [It may take some time to figure out how flex members would be demarcated in dacdb]
- [At all times flex members are encouraged to become individual Rotarians. Annual invoices can invite flex members to consider joining.]
- [The primary member is billed for dues and meal costs and how flex members divide that, if at all, is up to them.]
