Our club has approved an application for a District Matching grant for \$3,330 to resupply medical equipment to the John Dau Medical Clinic in South Sudan, which was damaged and looting during the recent civil war. The equipment identified to be included in this grant are, as Oxygen Concentrator, a Microscope and a Centrifuge. Jack Howard, of the John Dau Foundation worked with his committee to identify the needed equipment. The items are will be purchased locally and hand carried to the clinic by local volunteers traveling there in the following months. If approved by Rotary Foundation and the District, we anticipate the equipment will be purchased in late August or early September. 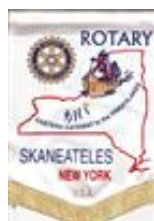
