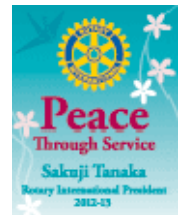

**LAST WEEK:** Holly Gregg and Jim Moore from the Citizens to Preserve the (Rural) Character of Skaneateles committee came to give their views on the proposed expansion of Victory Sports Medicine. Dr. Marc Pietropaoli bought almost One hundred acres on the east side of Skaneateles with the idea of expanding his business. According to Jim Moore and Holly Gregg when the original proposal was submitted to the governing bodies an estimate of 6,800 gallons of water would be used every day. Now that the scope of the project has been revealed that estimate may change to as high as 40,000 gallons. Gregg and Moore reminded the members that once water comes onto the property waste water and run off must leave it. Another point that Mr. Moore made several times is that in order for a facility of this size to be profitable there would necessarily be a large amount of tournaments. These events would occur on weekends throughout the year. The club has invited Dr. Pietropaoli or his representatives to come to a meeting and share with us their point of view on the project.
