President Cheryl reminded everybody that our District Conference is on April 29th & 30th. As in years past our club will be donating a gift to the District House of Friendship table.

Ward Vuillemot presented Chuck Williams with an ornate "Paul Harris Wine Stopper for his ongoing contributions to the Rotary Foundation.

Cathy Powell introduced her friend & our evening's speaker Ralph Singh. Ralph is Chairman & CEO of Wisdom Thinkers Network. This network is a diverse group of acclaimed thought leaders in business, education, science, poverty alleviation, environment, community & religious organizations who believe stories have the power to change the world. Ralph briefly reviewed the approaches he uses with school children. When Ralph speaks to elementary school students he utilizes foundational stories that are embedded in school culture. These stories are internalized by students & impact their behavior. Skillfully employing these stories ultimately show up in decreased behavior incidents & improved scores. In middle school, the older students are able to use stories they had internalized as children as a lens/filter in critical thinking to interpret the world around them. The young adult students in high school want their studies to be relevant to their lives & to feel that they have an impact on the world around them. Ralph stressed that "re-weaving the fabric" ties the community together instilling pride & creating the link between community & school. Ralph is, without question, one of the most thought provoking & inspirational speakers we've heard in many year
