Alan welcomes volunteers, and offered to give tours of the Syracuse Rescue Mission to our members.

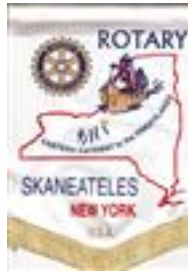
