LAST WEEK: ... by Bill Conole

Sir Nicholas Winton - Bill Conole briefly spoke on the illustrious life of Rotarian *Sir Nicholas Winton* who recently passed away at 106. Nicholas was a British humanitarian who organized the rescue of 669 children from the Nazi Death Camps in Czechoslovakia on the eve of the WW2. Nicholas personified Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self" by never seeking credit for his heroic exploits. Only after his wife found out about his actions in 1988, did Nicholas receive the recognition he so richly deserved.

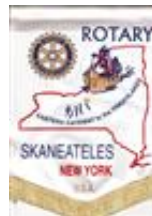
