LAST WEEK: We were visited by George Mango and Steve Poli of the Camillus Rotary Club. They were promoting A concert by renowned pianist Francesco Attesti. Our main speaker was Dr. Judith Pastel, Interm Superintendent of Schools. Dr. Pastel presented an overview of the coming school years budget. There are continued pressures on the budget from many of the internal operation costs increasing. In addition the district will see a marked increase in the contribution it will need to make to the state pension system and cost of benefits. Enrollment however continues to decline and this fall there will only be 83 children attending kindergarden. By contrast, in 1977 there was over 200 students.
