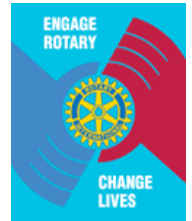

**LAST WEEK:** Franklin Fry, Executive Director for the Greater Syracuse Division of the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association spoke on the many programs the AHA has developed to combat heart disease in CNY. Franklin pointed out that heart disease is the leading cause of death in the US. Even though great strides have been made in treating heart disease, it remains a deadly health threat to Americans of all ages and sexes. Recently the AHA had conducted extensive research on heart disease in women. Under Franklin Fry's leadership the AHA is developing innovative educational and awareness campaigns related to cardiovascular disease and stroke. These programs include CPR Trailing, Go Red for Women, Healthy Eating and Walking and Heart Walks in Syracuse, Binghamton and Watertown. Franklin stressed that, though heart disease is the cause of death in the US it is 80% preventable. Franklin has deep roots in CNY and Skaneateles. His family has summered on Skaneateles Lake for five generations. With a life long love for this area, Franklin moved here full time three years ago, after spending 30 years in the New York City area.

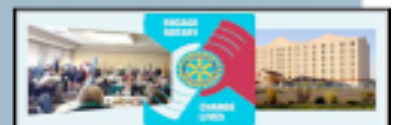
