**LAST WEEK:** Professor Judy VanBuskirk, SUNY Cortland, spoke on "The Women of the Golden Age". After graduating from LaSalle College Professor VanBuskirk was awarded a prestigious Fulbright Scholarship. For several years she worked for Xerox in Paris, Princeton & New York City. While attending graduate school in NYU she served as the Assistant Admissions Director of the NYU Graduate Scholl. Professor VanBuskirk received her PhD in history from NYU. Currently she is an Associate Professor in SUNY Cortland. Professor VanBuskirk started her presentation with quiz on the birth names & the stage names of famous actors & actresses. This quiz sparked a lively discussion among our Rotary members. Professor VanBuskirk told about the lives of some of our earliest female screen stars. Some of these stars were the most famous ladies in the world in the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Stars like Mary Pickford were strong, enterprising women who stood up to the film tycoons to gain access to producing & even directing some of their movies. Some of these early female stars, like Lillian Gish & Carol Lombard, pushed hard for their rights & for greater roles in writing scripts & in directing their movies. Professor VanBuskirk presented an interesting insight to the dynamic roles many of early females stars played in the pioneering days of the film industry.
