LAST WEEK: Jack Howard, a long time Skaneateles Resident, & John Dau, one of the legendary "Lost Boys" presented a program on the need to repair a medical in John's war torn village in Sudan. John first related the harrowing tale of how he & the "Lost Boy's" fled Sudan & spent years in several African refugee camps. Before coming to the US in 2001, John had little formal education. In spite of this Dau graduated from OCC & was among six honorees receiving the American Association of Community Colleges alumni award. After graduating from SU john established a foundation to build a medical clinic in his native village in 2007. In seven years this clinic provided medical services to more than 120,000 people. When the civil war erupted again in Sudan recently rebel soldiers nearly destroyed John's clinic. The undaunted John Dau is asking Rotarians to help him rebuild this desperately needed clinic. In the coming weeks our club can decide how we can help John rebuild this clinic.


