Upcoming charity golf tournament needs hole sponsors, door prizes, and a few volunteers

Just about three weeks away! On Sunday, August 8, Rotary Club of Utica's first annual charity golf tournament, Tees for Trees, will take place at Hidden Valley Golf Club in Whitesboro, NY. Event organizer Jerry Kraus says the golfer slots are almost filled up, but the following is still needed to ensure a successful event:

- **Hole Sponsors**: businesses or individuals can sponsor a sign for \$100; can use images (e.g., logo/card) and/or wording (e.g., "Let's go <business name> or "Good luck golfers"). See form on page 4.
- **Door Prizes:** prizes for the golfers will be drawn at random during dinner; prizes can be t-shirts, golf items, tickets to events, gift cards, gift baskets, etc.
- **Rotary Volunteers: 2 volunteers** needed to take 2 to 3 hour shifts to watch (sit in your lawn chair) the "Hole in One" car and authenticate golfers attempt to hit a hole-in-one shot; **1 or 2 volunteers** needed to sell 50-50 raffle tickets from 12-1 p.m. (includes free lunch) and dinner hour (estimate 5-6 p.m., includes free dinner); **photographer volunteer** needed during lunch hour (12-1 p.m., includes free lunch) to take pictures of 4-some groups, run them to Rite Aid or wherever to get prints, and return them to Hidden Valley for golfers to pick up at dinner.
