This Week's Program

7 Hamlets Brewery is a locally owned and operated farm brewery and tap room in Westmoreland, NY. Keith Richards and Matthew Taylor, owners and brewers at 7 Hamlets, started brewing as a hobby in 2013. They started brewing on a 5-gallon homemade system then, after a few years, they decided to purchase an electric one-barrel system consisting of three 55gallon stainless steel kettles. Their goal was to perfect their craft and open a brewery.

In 2019, Richards and Taylor purchased a building in their hometown of Westmoreland, N.Y. With the help and support of friends and family, the building was transformed into 7 Hamlets Brewing Company, which opened for business in March 2020.
