Kyle Bass is the author of *Possessing Harriet*, which premiered at Syracuse Stage in 2018, was produced by Franklin Stage Company in 2019, and will be produced at East Lynne Theater Company in 2022. His new play *salt/city/blues* premieres at Syracuse Stage in 2022. Kyle is the co-author of the original screenplay for the film *Day of Days*, released by Broad Green Pictures in 2017, starring award-winning veteran actor Tom Skerritt. With Ping Chong, Kyle is the co-author of *Cry for Peace: Voices from the Congo*, which premiered at Syracuse Stage and was subsequently produced at La MaMa Experimental Theatre in New York. Kyle is the author of the libretto for a new opera based on legendary folk singer and guitarist Libba Cotten, commissioned by the Society for New Music. In addition to being Assistant Professor in the Department of



Theater at Colgate University, Kyle is Associate Artistic Director at Syracuse Stage, and was the 2019/20 Susan P. Stroman Visiting Playwright at the University of Delaware. Kyle is two-time recipient of the New York Foundation for the Arts (NYFA) Fellowship (for fiction in 1998, for playwriting in 2010), was a finalist for the Princess Grace Playwriting Award, and is a proud member of the Dramatists Guild of America.
